# Background

Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs) continue to rise in young people aged 16-24 age within Devon and Torbay, with 2023 seeing an alarming rise in the number of gonorrhoea cases in young people in the region.

This six-month campaign is aimed primarily at young people aged 16-24 living in Devon and Torbay, and has been designed to:

- » help raise awareness of STIs
- » encourage conversations about safe sex
- » provide an opportunity to signpost additional sexual health messaging including STI testing and free condom schemes

By supporting this campaign, you can help empower young people and encourage them to protect themselves and their partners and to help de-stigmatise conversations about safe sex.

This is a fun campaign, aimed to attract attention and encourage engagement. The final campaign has used audience feedback to ensure it resonated with the target group. Our research with young people has also shown that they trust information that has NHS branding.
